


Grizzly Engagement Project

T: I want to do this by July 1st 2022

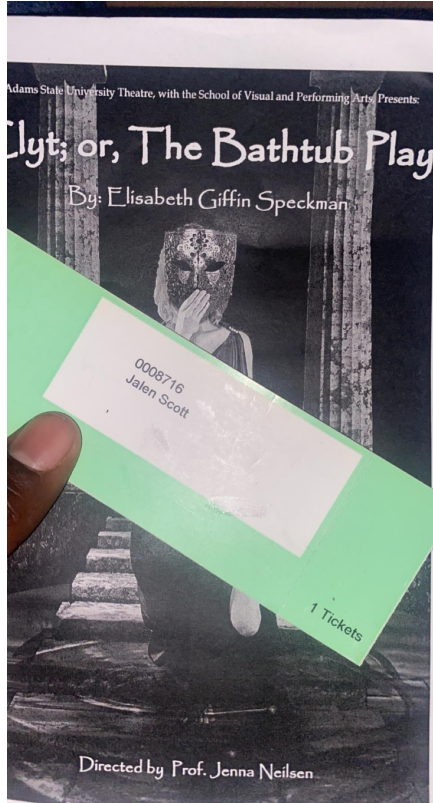


Grizzly Engagement Experience
